### SNARE DRUM/MULTI-TENOR CATEGORY

*Revised January 2022*

#### **ABOUT:**

- This competition evaluates the student's ability to perform musically on snare drum or multi-tenors.
- Any published solo that is festival appropriate may be performed.
- Time slots vary by division, please see division specific guidelines for more information.
- Any competitor that goes over time may be disqualified from competition, and provided comments only on their performance (judge's discretion).
- The top performers from each division will be recognized at the final concert and awards ceremony.

#### **PROVIDED EQUIPMENT:**

- 14" Orchestral Snare Drum on Concert Height Stand
- 14x12" Rudimental Marching Drum with Kevlar Head on appropriate stand.
- Large Quints (6-10-12-13-14) with mylar heads on appropriate stand.
- Piano (by request during registration)
- Participants are invited to bring their own equipment for this category.

#### **DIVISIONS and DIVISION SPECIFIC GUIDELINES:**

- Grades 6-8 and Grades 9-10 (separate divisions)
  - o Time Limit: Six Minutes
  - o Orchestral Snare, Rudimental Snare, and Multi-Tenor Solos are all evaluated in same category.
- Grades 11-12
  - o Time Limit: Eight Minutes
  - o Orchestral Snare, Rudimental Snare, and Multi-Tenor Solos are all evaluated in same category.
- College
  - o Time Limit: Eight Minutes
  - o Category 1: Orchestral Snare Solos
  - o Category 2: Rudimental Snare and Multi-Tenor Solos
